MOTION TO RESCHEDULE DEADLINE FOR
FILING COMMENTS IN RM2004-1
(February 27, 2004)

The Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA) hereby moves to have the Commission reschedule the deadline for filing comments from March 1, 2004, to March 15, 2004, a postponement of two weeks. In Order No. 1389, the Commission established March 1, 2004, as the deadline for filing comments on its proposed definition of postal services to be added to the Commission's rules and regulations. April 1, 2004, was established as the date for reply comments. Both deadlines were very generous in the amount of time allotted for preparing comments.

Unfortunately, the undersigned has received word of an urgent deadline that must take precedence over the filing of comments. Therefore, OCA will be unable to file comments any earlier than March 15. In order to avoid any unfair advantage over those planning to comment, OCA respectfully requests that the deadline for everyone be pushed back two weeks. OCA suggests that the reply date also be postponed for two weeks – to April 15, 2004.

My apologies to the Commission and anyone planning to comment who is in any way inconvenienced by this request.
