MOTION OF TIME WARNER INC. ET AL. FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE
OF RESPONSE TO ABM/TW ET AL.-T1-3
(May 26, 2004)

Time Warner Inc., Condé Nast Publications, a Division of Advance Magazine Publishers Inc., Newsweek, Inc., The Reader's Digest Association, Inc., and TV Guide Magazine Group, Inc. (collectively, Time Warner Inc. et al.) respectfully move for acceptance two weeks late of the response of witness Stralberg (TW et al.-T-2) to American Business Media interrogatory ABM/TW et al.-T1-3, filed April 28, 2004, redirected from witness Mitchell.

Preparation of a response to this interrogatory required assembling, analyzing, and organizing in a consistent format substantial amounts of data from each of the five co-complainants, a task not possible within the customary 14-day period allowed for interrogatory responses. Counsel for ABM was apprised of the expected delay and consented to a 2-week extension of the date for a response. Time Warner et al. is authorized to state that ABM does not object to the granting of this motion.
