IN SUPPORT OF STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT  
(June 15, 2004)

Pursuant to the Presiding Officer's Ruling No. MC2004-1/5, dated May 27, 2004, and Rule 30(e)(2) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, the Office of the Consumer Advocate (OCA) hereby submits its comments on the revised Stipulation and Agreement filed by the Postal Service on May 26, 2004. The revised agreement includes, at the request of the OCA, a data collection plan.

The record of this proceeding indicates that the financial consequences of the experiment should be positive, although small. See Response of witness Taufique to ABM/USPS-T1-31. As a consequence, the OCA supports the Stipulation and Agreement.
