STATEMENT OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
CONCERNING COMPLIANCE WITH FILING REQUIREMENTS
AND CONDITIONAL MOTION FOR WAIVER
(June 21, 2004)

In the Compliance Statement (Attachment E) to the Request, the Postal Service has identified information contained in its testimony and supporting documentation intended to satisfy the filing requirements in pertinent provisions of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (Rules 193 and 196). The Postal Service has supplemented materials developed specifically for this filing by incorporating documentation that was submitted by the Postal Service in Docket No. MC2002-2, the proceeding that addressed the baseline Negotiated Service Agreement (NSA) with Capital One. The Compliance Statement specifically addresses each filing requirement, and indicates which parts of the Postal Service's filing satisfy each rule. Docket No. MC2002-2 materials are also incorporated by reference.

The Postal Service believes that the specific requirements set forth in Rules 193 and 196 have been met. If the Commission concludes that these materials and

incorporations are not sufficient, the Postal Service respectfully moves that those requirements be waived, pursuant to 39 C.F.R. §§ 3001.193(a).
