PostCom members include the nation’s largest advertising mailers, printers, and shippers. Its membership encompasses both commercial and non-profit entities, and includes the largest customers of the United States Postal Service. PostCom members have used or have considered using repositionable notes on letters since April,

2003. As such, PostCom is interested in this proposal, which increases rates for Standard Mail letter services already provided under the existing rules.

PostCom opposes the Postal Service's proposal. This proceeding represents the first time in which the Postal Service has proposed to introduce rates not based on cost-of-service; and it does so under the existing statutory framework, in a non-competitive market. Nevertheless, because PostCom anticipates raising issues of law and policy in this proceeding, and does not currently anticipate raising issues of fact that cannot be resolved on the pleadings, PostCom does not expect that a hearing will be necessary.
