MOTION OF UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE OF WITNESS ARNETTA L. COBB'S
RESPONSES TO INTERROGATORIES OF
THE OFFICE OF THE CONSUMER ADVOCATE
(OCA/USPS-T1-23-24)

The United States Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance of the responses of witness Arnetta L. Cobb to interrogatories OCA/USPS-T1-23-24, filed on January 27, 2005 by the Office of the Consumer Advocate. These responses were delayed by one day because they required witness Cobb to obtain detailed information from a number of sources within the Postal Service and to get the agreement of all those sources regarding the responses. Postal Service counsel advised the OCA yesterday that this one-day delay would occur. The Postal Service does not believe that this brief delay has prejudiced any participant in this proceeding.
