TO DESIGNATE ADDITIONAL WRITTEN CROSS-EXAMINATION
OF UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE WITNESS ARNETTA L. COBB (USPS-T-1)
(March 15, 2005)

The Office of the Consumer Advocate hereby moves to designate an additional interrogatory response in this proceeding. Designations were due to be filed March 14, 2005 and the OCA designated several interrogatory responses but inadvertently omitted a response of witness Cobb, DBP/USPS-T3-1, redirected from witness Abdirahman. The omitted response is significant as it explains, in part, the breadth of PFS service available to multiple residents in a household. It is also cross-referenced as the answer to interrogatory OCA/USPS-T1-1 which was designated.

The Postal Service has indicated it does not oppose this motion.
