REVISED MOTION FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE OF RESPONSE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE TO INTERROGATORY OF VALPAK DIRECT MARKETING SYSTEMS, INC. AND VALPAK DEALERS' ASSOCIATION, INC., REDIRECTED FROM WITNESS LEWIS (ERRATA)
(VP/USPS-T30-18)

On May 9, 2005, the United States Postal Service moved for late acceptance of the response of witness Abdirahman to the following interrogatory of the Valpak Direct Marketing Systems, Inc. and Valpak Dealers' Association, Inc.: VP/USPS-T30-18, and redirected from witness Lewis. The text of the motion erred in that the Postal Service provided an institutional response.

Thus, the Postal Service now moves for the late acceptance of *its* response to VP/USPS-T30-18, which was filed on May 9, 2005, one business day late. The delay was due to technical difficulties experienced while preparing the answer for electronic filing. No party will be prejudiced by this short delay.
