MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE FOR ACCEPTANCE
OF LATE FILING OF RESPONSES TO
PRESIDING OFFICER'S INFORMATION REQUEST NO. 3
(May 18, 2005)

The United States Postal Service hereby moves that the Postal Rate Commission accept for filing today the responses to Question 1, 2 and 3(a-b) of Presiding Officer's Information Request No. 3, issued on April 29, 2005. Due to have been filed on May 13, 2005, the responses are five calendar days late. Preparation of the responses required consultations among analysts that could not be completed until this week and was complicated by the interrelationship between their subject matter and the preparation of errata to testimony that will be filed very shortly. The Postal Service regrets the delay, but considers that it was necessary in order to ensure complete and accurate responses.
