LIBRARY REFERENCE USPS-LR-K-48 (ERRATA)

The United States Postal Service hereby provides notice that it is filing a CD with the revised Excel files, dated May 23, 2004, for inclusion in:

USPS-LR-K-48, Test Year Letter/Card Processing Cost Models (FCM, Standard Mail, and Nonmachinable Surcharge)

The enclosed CD replaces the CD originally filed in this library reference.

The revision makes the following changes:

1. In Excel files LR-K-48FCLTRS and LR-K-48STDLETRS, two cost pools are reclassified to be consistent with the testimony of witness Abdirahman: 1CANCEL cost pool is reclassified from non-worksharing related fixed to worksharing related fixed cost pool and 1MTRPREP cost pool is reclassified from worksharing related proportional cost pool to worksharing related fixed cost pool.
- 2- On the Summary page of Excel file LR-K-48FCLTRS, Cells E23 and F23, the 5-digit costs are weight averaged between Automation 5-digit and Automation 5-digit (CCBCS/ Manual sites), which is consistent with the Postal Service methodology in USPS-LR-J-60.

3-On the MISC page of Excel files LR-K-48FCLTRS and LR-K-STDLETRS, the RCR volume is revised to reflect the actual base year volume.

4- On the Wage Rate and Piggyback page of Excel files LR-K-48FCLTRS and LR-K-STDLETRS, the Premium Pay factor is now revised to 1.014 to reflect the accurate Single Piece Letters premium pay factor.
