NOTICE OF UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE OF FILING OF
TESTIMONY OF WITNESS PAGE (USPS-T-23)
(May 24, 2005)

The United States Postal Service hereby provides notice of the filing of the testimony of witness Page (USPS-T-23). This testimony replaces the testimony of witness Moser, the original USPS-T-23, who has withdrawn from this docket because of a change in employment. The new USPS-T-23 consists mainly of the following sections from witness Moser's testimony: sections I (Purpose and Scope of Testimony), II (Guide to Testimony and Supporting Documentation), VII (Express Mail Rate Category Cost Differentials, XV (Stamped Envelopes), and XVII (Final Adjustments), and the appropriate portions of section XVIII (Proposed Changes Relative to PRC Methodology). Section numbers and table numbers are adjusted appropriately, and the references to library references K-59 and K-111 are modified to refer to only Attachments 5, 12B, and 14. On page 2, the reference to witness Bernstein is corrected to witness Thress.

The Final Adjustments presented in witness Moser's Tables 11 and 13 are revised, reflecting three changes: (a) revised letter costs in errata to library references K-48 and K-110, to be filed shortly; (b) revised Delivery Confirmation costs, filed today in errata to USPS-T-24, Table 1; and (c) corrected cell references in both the Vehicle Service Drivers and Transportation sheets of Attachment 14a in library references K-59

and K-111, in the Parcel Post line. The revised Final Adjustments are presented in witness Page's Tables 3 and 5.

The new USPS-T-23 is being filed separately today.
