MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE FOR LATE
ACCEPTANCE OF THE RESPONSES OF WITNESS KELLEY
TO VALPAK INTERROGATORIES (VP/USPS-T16-12, 14, 19-29)
(June 9, 2005)

The United States Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance of the responses of witness Kelley to the following interrogatories of ValPak: VP/USPS-T16-12 and 14, filed on May 20, and VP/USPS-T16-19-29, filed on May 24, 2005. The delay with respect to questions 12 and 14 (which are identical) was caused by the amount of time needed to respond. Submission of responses to 19 through 29 was delayed by attendance of the witness and counsel at Tuesday's technical conference, plus subsequent complications. No party should be prejudiced by these relatively minor delays.
