ADVO/USPS-T30-1. In response to an example posed in VP/USPS-T30-5, you state that . . . “normally, where carriers are delivering to centralized, cluster box, curblines, and dismount deliveries, they would take both sequenced mailings directly to the street uncased.” In response to VP/USPS-T30-30, you state that . . . “Where City carriers serve sections of curblines deliveries on a route, they should take both components of detached address label mailings directly to the street for those sections.” Is that also the case where carriers are delivering to centralized, cluster box, or dismount deliveries or sections?
