The American Bankers Association and the National Association of Presort Mailers hereby file this Request for Leave to File Out of Time Identification of Expected Amount of Oral Cross Examination of Postal Service Witness Robinson (USPS-T27).

The ABA and NAPM filed on June 9, 2005 herein their Identification of Expected Amount of Cross Examination of Postal Service witnesses ( Group A and B). ABA & NAPM have subsequently determined that they would like to conduct a light amount of oral cross examination of Postal Service witness Maura Robinson (USPS-T27).
