ANSWER OF ADVO INC. TO VAL-PAK MOTION FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE DIRECT TESTIMONY

(July 11, 2005)

On July 6, 2005, Val-Pak filed a motion seeking a five-day extension of time (three working days) for filing its direct case, until July 19th. Advo takes no position on whether Val-Pak's motion should be granted. However, the effect of granting its motion, without adjustments to subsequent procedural dates, would be to shorten the already condensed periods for discovery and filing of rebuttal testimony. Accordingly, if Val-Pak's motion is granted, the Commission should also extend the deadline for discovery with respect to Val-Pak's testimony by an equivalent three working days until August 10th, and extend the date for rebuttal to Val-Pak until September 13th.
