**Q.** Tr. 6/2413-15. Please provide a timetable for obtaining an estimate of the number or percentage of delivery points for all routes or any section of routes where the carrier is restricted in the number of bundles that can be carried.

**RESPONSE:**

We expect that, within the next two weeks or so, information may become available on possible deliveries by delivery mode, which will not provide an exact count of stops where the bundle restriction applies, but should give us a more reliable indication of where it is likely to apply.
