**Motion Of Major Mailers Association For Leave To File Out-Of-Time
Additional Materials For Inclusion In The Evidentiary Record**

Ordering Paragraph 3 of Presiding Officer's Ruling No. 41, issued July 7, 2005, set July 19, 2005 as the deadline for designating as part of the evidentiary record responses to questions posed during hearings on the Postal Service's case-in-chief. Today, Major Mailers Association (MMA) is submitting additional materials for inclusion in the evidentiary record.¹

There is good cause to grant this motion for leave to file the additional materials out of time. The materials MMA is submitting are responses of USPS witness McCrery to questions posed by undersigned counsel for MMA.
