MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE  
FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE OF DESIGNATION OF RESPONSES OF VALPAK  
WITNESS MITCHELL (USPS/VP-T1-1 – 12)

Witness Mitchell filed responses to Postal Service interrogatories on August 19 and August 22, 2005. Through administrative oversight and miscommunication, no party made a request at the hearing on August 24 that those responses be admitted into evidence and transcribed. This situation became apparent upon review of the August 24 transcript. The Postal Service now moves for leave to make a late designation of the responses of witness Mitchell to USPS/VP-T1-1 – 12, and requests that those responses be transcribed in a subsequent volume of the record. Counsel for Valpak has stated that he has no objection to this request. Two copies of the indicated responses are being submitted to the Docket Section with this request.
