**NOTICE OF FILING OF CATEGORY 4 LIBRARY REFERENCE  
(BOOKSPAN-LR-1)**

**(September 21, 2005)**

Bookspan hereby gives notice that is filing Category 4 Library Reference BOOKSPAN-LR-1. This library reference consists of various Bookspan New Member solicitation mailpieces. The material is provided in response to discovery requests. More specifically, OCA/BOOKSPAN-T1-5, filed September 6, 2005, and OCA/BOOKSPAN-T1-7 filed September 7, 2005 request examples of Bookspan solicitation mailpieces, including inserts.

The filing of this material as a Library Reference is necessary, appropriate, and consistent with the Commission's rules because the physical characteristics of this material render compliance with filing and service requirements unduly burdensome. 39 C.F.R. §3001.31(b)(2)(ii). Furthermore, the material is filed in compliance with a discovery request for the production of documents (physical mailpieces), use of the material is facilitated if it is filed as a library reference, and interest in this material is likely to be limited. 39 C.F.R. §3001.31(b)(2)(ii)(D), (C) and (A).

Pursuant to Commission rules, Bookspan seeks waiver of the Commission's requirement to file two hard copies, 39 C.F.R. § 3001.31(b)(2)(viii) and (x).

The interrogatories request "examples" of "the entire mailpiece as it was mailed to prospective customers." The source of the mailpieces (other than the printed copies of inserts included) is a collection of individual mailpieces from past mailings sent to a Bookspan employee as a seed for tracking and quality control purposes. Two copies of each mailpiece therefore cannot be reasonably or timely produced in the format requested.

Bookspan also seeks waiver of the Commission's requirement to file an electronic version of the Library Reference. Again recognizing the source of the mailpieces, corresponding material is generally not readily accessible in electronic version, may no longer be available, and, in any event, would not be wholly responsive to the OCA's request. However, electronic copies of certain documents are provided to the extent readily available. Such documents include copies of inserts in PDF or JPG format, as available.
