

DFS does not object to reopening the record to accept the two pieces of testimony which Chase and the Postal Service would like to submit. DFS would not, at this time, anticipate engaging in any discovery on that material.

DFS does think that due process would require that any party, even a signatory to the settlement agreement, be accorded the opportunity to partake in discovery. DFS would think that, since the material is being submitted in support of the positions taken in the settlement agreement, that little discovery will result.
