

could be significantly affected by the rate and classification proposals of the United States Postal Service.

At this stage of the proceeding, it is unknown whether the Postal Service's request for rate and classification changes, as proposed, is in accordance with the Postal Reorganization Act. *See* 39 U.S.C. sections 3622 and 3623.

APMU takes no position at this time on the need for a hearing.
