**COMMENTS OF BOOKSPAN ON NOTICE OF INQUIRY NO. 1
IN REGARD TO DOMESTIC MAIL CLASSIFICATION SCHEDULE AND
DATA COLLECTION PLAN LANGUAGE**

Bookspan hereby provides its comments on Notice of Inquiry No. 1, issued on November 3, 2005. The NOI seeks comments on suggested clarifying changes to proposed DMCS sections 620.11 and 620.12 and to a revised data collection and reporting plan. Bookspan accepts all of the suggested revisions, with two exceptions.

First, as noted in the responses of the Postal Service and Bookspan to POIR No. 3, question 2, the NSA is not intended to be limited to Standard Mail Regular letters, but includes all Standard Mail letters, including ECR letters. This affects the Commission's suggested revisions to Sections 620.11 and 620.12.

Second, Bookspan believes that in the Commission's suggested revision to section 620.11, in the first sentence, the word "and" immediately before "(2)..." should be changed to "or". Bookspan believes that the Postal Service's original proposal using the word "or" was correct because both qualifications need not be met for a mailpiece to qualify. If the Commission determines that its use of "and" is correct, Bookspan accepts the revision provided the Commission interprets the provision consistent with the above.
