The Postal Service hereby files the following errata to its Comments filed on January 23, 2006. Footnote 1 on page 2 is revised to clarify, as explained in witness Daniel's testimony, that the labels no longer bear the address of a particular post office or designate a facility type. USPS-T-1, at 4-6. The footnote is revised to state:

Based on the modifications made during the experiment and to be continued if the service becomes permanent, the RDU rate is charged for parcels captured and picked up at a delivery unit, and the RBMC rates are charged for parcels captured and picked up at a BMC.
