In response to Order No. 1460, I have not identified any genuine issues of material fact that exist on the question of whether the Disney stamped stationery, which I now describe generically as stamped lettersheets, ¹ is a postal service. Although I discussed some facts in my answer in opposition to the Postal Service's motion to dismiss that I did not introduce in my complaint, I believe that the Commission may take official notice of these facts pursuant to Rule 31(j). Therefore, no genuine issues of material fact exist on the question of whether stamped lettersheets are a postal service.
