2. NAPUS is a management association, whose dues-paying members include approximately 41,000 active and retired postmasters in the United States. NAPUS members derive their livelihood from employment with the U.S. Postal Service, or receive annuities and health coverage as result of prior employment with the Postal Service.
3. NAPUS represents the approximately 27,000 postmasters who manage individual postal facilities throughout the nation. Moreover, NAPUS members serve as the vital link between postal reliant communities and U.S. postal policy. Actions taken by the Postal Service to alter postal classifications, rates and fees for special services affect the working conditions of NAPUS members and impact the communities in which postmasters serve.
4. Consequently, NAPUS has a strong and statutory interest in matters to be heard and decided in this proceeding of such nature that its intervention is necessary and appropriate.
