MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE OF THE FILING OF ITS RESPONSES TO
INTERROGATORIES OCA/USPS-39 AND 40
(June 5, 2006)

The United States Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance of the filing of its responses to the following interrogatories of the Office of the Consumer Advocate: OCA/USPS-39 and 40. The responses were due to have been filed on May 31, 2006. They were prepared for filing on June 1, 2006, as part of a set that was to have ranging from OCA/USPS-35 to 43. However, the responses to OCA/USPS-39 and 40 were inadvertently not included in that set, an oversight that was brought to the attention of the Postal Service by the Docket Section this morning. The Postal Service regrets the oversight, but believes that the prejudice to the parties is minimal.
