**NOTICE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
CONCERNING FILING OF REVISIONS TO REQUEST AND TESTIMONY**
(June 7, 2006)

The United States Postal Service is today filing several documents revising materials relating to the testimony of witness Ayub (USPS-T-1) and the Request for a Recommended Decision in this docket. Specifically, Appendix A to witness Ayub's testimony, the Request, and Attachments A and B to the Request have been revised to reflect (i) new historical volume estimates by Washington Mutual Bank (WMB) and/or (ii) the execution of an amendment to the NSA entered into by the parties, which revises the discount schedules in the original agreement. The amendment to the NSA agreement with WMB, which was executed on June 6, is added to Attachment F of the Request. WMB's errata to its testimony and notice of revisions have been filed today in separate documents. Witness Ayub's testimony has also been revised to reflect the updated cost data presented in Docket No. R2006-1.

Revised Appendix A to witness Ayub's testimony is included in today's filing. Changes to the testimony of witness Ayub will be filed tomorrow.

All changes are attached to this filing and will be shown in highlighted text.

As background, by Joint Motion dated May 15, 2006, Washington Mutual Bank (WMB) and the Postal Service moved for a temporary suspension of proceedings based, in part, on the need to address corrections to be made to the presentation of WMB's historical volumes. On May 15, 2006, the Presiding Officer issued P.O. Ruling No. MC2006-3/2, which directed the parties to either file revisions to testimony by May 26, or file a status report. The parties engaged in ongoing discussions to reach an agreement on amendments to the original filing. In subsequent status reports dated May 26 and June 2, 2006, the parties requested extensions until June 7, 2006 to agree upon, finalize, and file all revised documents.

Finally, with respect to outstanding discovery, consistent with P.O. Ruling No. MC2006-3/2, the parties reassert their intention to file any objections within 10 days and responses within 14 days of today's filing.
