The United States Postal Service hereby provides a status report on the following interrogatories of ValPak, Inc., filed on June 21, 2006: VP/USPS-T14-13 -14. These questions have been redirected to the Postal Service. They relate to the same 2004 data collection effort that was the subject of POIR No. 4, items 4-12. As indicated in the June 9, 2006 status report filed by the Postal Service with respect to the POIR No. 4 items, much work needs to be done before the dataset in question can be prepared, and responses regarding such a dataset can be provided. Therefore, the Postal Service anticipates providing responses to VP/USPS-T13 – 14 concurrently with its responses to POIR No. 4, items 4-12.
