**NOTICE OF FILING OF REQUEST OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
FOR A RECOMMENDED DECISION ON CHANGE OF DEFINITION OF NOMINAL
RATE FOR PERIODICALS SUBSCRIPTIONS**

Pursuant to 39 C.F.R. § 69b(d), the Postal Service hereby gives notice that it is filing a request for a recommended decision to change the definition of nominal rate for Periodicals subscriptions. Interested parties have 26 days from today, that is, until August 1, 2006, to intervene as a participant in this proceeding. The Postal Service hopes that a settlement of this minor change will be possible, since it would relax an eligibility requirement, is not expected to harm anymailers, and is believed to be helpful to many Periodicals customers.
