NOTICE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
REGARDING STATUS OF RDC ACTIVATION DOCUMENTS
(July 7, 2006)

The United States Postal Service hereby submits a further status report on the production of the RDC Activation Plan and the RDC Communications Plan referenced in the June 16, 2006 APWU Motion to Extend Discovery.

Contrary to earlier expectations, the internal review process through which these related draft documents are being circulated is not expected to be completed before July 21st. The Postal Service now expects the documents to be finalized during the week of July 24-28.

Should the Commission deem it appropriate to grant the APWU Motion, and should this result in a delay of the hearings currently scheduled for July 18-19, the Postal Service respectfully requests that the Commission take into consideration the unavailability of the Postal Service's witnesses throughout the month of August, as indicated in the Postal Service's June 30, 2006, Reply to the APWU Motion.
