2. Time Warner provides Internet service, publishes and distributes books and magazines, and is actively engaged in the fields of filmed entertainment, recorded music, music publishing, cable television programming, and cable television systems.

3. Time Warner is a large user of Periodicals class mail and thus has a substantial interest in the issues raised in this proceeding.

4. Time Warner supports the classification change requested by the Postal Service in this docket.

5. For the reasons stated in the Request of the United States Postal Service (filed July 6, 2006), at 2, Time Warner agrees that this case is appropriate for consideration under the Commission's rules for expedited minor classification cases (39 C.F.R. §§ 3001.6969c).

6. Time Warner shares the expectation of the Postal Service that the proposed change will not be controversial and will not harm any mailer (Request at 1-2) . Time Warner therefore agrees that this is an appropriate case in which to seek settlement and intends to participate actively in settlement discussions.
