NOTICE OF INTENT TO FILE TESTIMONY  
(July 21, 2006)**

Pursuant to Presiding Officer's Ruling No. 29, the American Postal Workers Union, AFL-CIO (APWU) hereby gives notice of its intent to file a direct case in this proceeding.

While the APWU is diligently working to prepare its direct case and provide it to the Commission as expeditiously as possible, certain constraints, namely the APWU National Convention, preparation for and participation in the R2006-1 omnibus rate case hearings and prior commitments of our witness, require that the APWU have at least four weeks to prepare the direct testimony.
