UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE MOTION FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE
OF RESPONSE OF WITNESS WILLIAMS TO INTERROGATORY OCA/USPS-T2-22
(July 25, 2006)

The United States Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance of the filing yesterday of the response of witness Williams to the following interrogatory:
OCA/USPS-T2-22. Due on June 27th, the response was filed 27 calendar days late. The response required an exhaustive search for AMP records at headquarters and the field dating back more than a decade ago in order to compile as much responsive information as could be located. The Postal Service regrets the delay, but believes that no party has been materially prejudiced by an effort to conduct as thorough a search as possible in order to be as responsive as possible.
