MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE FOR
LATE ACCEPTANCE OF FILING OF RESPONSES OF WITNESS TAUFIQUE
TO INTERROGATORIES OF THE OFFICE OF THE CONSUMER ADVOCATE
(OCA/USPS-T32-19 AND 20)

The United States Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance of its filing of the response of witness Altaf H. Taufique to the following interrogatories of the Office of the Consumer Advocate: OCA/USPS-T32-19 and 20. The responses were due to have been filed on July 26, 2006. The press of business prevented the preparation of the responses until two days later, on Friday the 28th. However, all internal review of the responses could no be completed in time to permit them to be filed on that day. As a consequence, they could not be filed until today, Monday the 31st, five calendar days. The Postal Service regrets the delay, but believes that no party has been prejudiced by it.
