Pursuant to Rule 30 (e)(3) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, the Office of the Consumer Advocate hereby gives notice of intent to conduct oral cross-examination of Postal Service witness Yeh (USPS-T-38). The subject of the cross-examination will relate to the Postal Service's decision to bar retail customers of Bound Printed Matter from Postal Service counters and to require them to pay for Bound Printed Matter only by means of "customer-generated postage meter" or permit imprint.
