MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE OF ITS NOTICE OF DESIGNATION OF WRITTEN
CROSS-EXAMINATION OF DIGISTAMP WITNESS BORGERS
(August 11, 2006)

Presiding Officer's Ruling No. C2004-2/6 (August 8, 2006) set August 15th for the hearing on the testimony of Postal Service witness Foti, and August 10th as the date for notices of designation of written cross examination of witness Foti. Between efforts to prepare for that hearing and ongoing hearings in the rate case, the Postal Service failed to appreciate that the same Order also set August 10th as the date for notices of designation of written cross-examination of DigiStamp witness Borgers. The Postal Service moves for leave to file its notice one-day late, and submits that no party will be prejudiced by this minimal delay.
