CONDUCT ORAL CROSS-EXAMINATION OF  
UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE WITNESS DONALD J. O'HARA (USPS-T-31)

Amazon.com, Inc. hereby moves for leave to file its Notice of Intent to Conduct Oral Cross-Examination of United States Postal Service Witness Donald J. O'Hara (USPS-T-31) one day out of time.

During oral cross-examination of Postal Service witness Yeh (USPS-T-38) on August 11, 2006, witness Yeh was asked to provide information about the percentage of books in Bound Printed Matter which bears on coverage, a topic that also was addressed by witness O'Hara, USPS-T-31, p. 33. *See* Tr. 8/1996, l. 11 – 1997, l. 21. This information had not been provided as of last Friday, August 25, 2006, and this omission had not been noticed until today. Amazon.com, Inc. seeks oral cross-examination as to witness O'Hara's understanding about the percentage of books in various parcel classes and his proposed coverage for Bound Printed Matter, particularly in the absence of timely information from witness Yeh.

Further, Amazon.com, Inc. believes that no party will be prejudiced by acceptance of this late filing.
