NOTICE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
OF A PARTIAL WITHDRAWAL OF ITS OPPOSITION TO
MOTION OF TIME WARNER INC. TO DESIGNATE EVIDENCE
FROM OTHER COMMISSION DOCKETS
(August 29, 2006)

The Postal Service hereby withdraws its opposition to all of the designations indicated in Time Warner Inc.'s Motion to Designate Evidence From Other Commission Dockets (filed August 9, 2006), except for witness McCrery's response to TW/USPS-T29-1 in Docket No. R2005-1, and witness Kingsley's response to AOL-TW/USPS-T39-16(a-b) in Docket No. R2001-1. Information contained in witness McCrery's response to TW/USPS-T29-1 in Docket No. R2001-1 is no longer valid, and has been updated in witness McCrery's response to TW/USPS-T42-29 in Docket No. R2006-1. Machine throughput information contained in witness Kingsley's Docket No. R2001-1 response to AOL-TW/USPS-T39-16(a) has been updated in witness McCrery's Docket No. R2006-1 testimony, and machine operating information contained in the response to AOL-TW/USPS-T39-16(b) has been updated in witness McCrery's Docket No. R2006-1 response to TW/USPS-T42-37(b). It is the Postal Service's position that incorrect, invalid, and/or outdated information from previous dockets should

not be given status as evidence in this case.¹ Consequently, the Postal Service continues to oppose the designation of witness McCreery's response to TW/USPS-T29-1 in Docket No. R2005-1, and witness Kingsley's response to AOL-TW/USPS-T39-16(a-b) in Docket No. R2001-1 as evidence in Docket No. R2006-1.
