MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE FOR
LATE ACCEPTANCE OF DESIGNATIONS OF WRITTEN CROSS-
EXAMINATION FOR WITNESSES KOBE (APWU-T-1), BUC (PB-T-2), AND
THOMPSON (OCA-T-4)

The United States Postal Service hereby moves for acceptance, one day late, of the designations of written cross-examination for: American Postal Workers Union, AFL-CIO, witness Kathryn Kobe (APWU-T-1); Pitney Bowes Inc. witness Lawrence Buc (PB-T-2); and Office of Consumer Advocate witness Pamela A. Thompson (OCA-T-4). The press of other business in this docket, as well as Docket No. N2006-1, inhibited Postal Service counsel's ability to compile the packet of designated interrogatories for a timely filing. The Postal Service has today delivered two copies of the designated interrogatories to the Commission, and therefore submits that no party has been materially prejudiced by this brief delay.
