LIBRARY REFERENCE USPS-LR-L-189 [ERRATA]

The United States Postal Service hereby provides notice that today it is filing a revised CD-ROM for the following Category 4 library reference, under the protective conditions set forth in Presiding Officer's Ruling No. R2006-1/51 (August 21, 2006):

USPS-LR-L-189 - Periodicals Publications Data Provided in Response to POIR No. 19 (**Filed Under Protective Conditions**).

The revised CD-ROM replaces the original CD-ROM. It adds data for 71 more publications. Thus, data for 259 publications have now been provided. The Postal Service considers this a complete response to the request in Presiding Officer's Information Request No. 19 (POIR 19) for "data from as many of the same 251 [Docket No. C2004-1] publications as are currently mailing." POIR 19 at 2. Data for more than 251 publications are being provided because of the inclusion of replacement publications (sometimes more than one) when one of the original 251 publications could not be included. Thus, the Postal Service believes it is today complying with

paragraphs 2, 3, and 4 of Presiding Officer's Ruling No. R2006-1/81, at 5.

In addition, the revised CD-ROM includes in column AS the count of all containers for each publication, instead of the count of just sacks. The count of all containers is needed for calculating the container rate postage for each publication, under the Postal Service's proposal. Some data entry errors for the first 30 sample publications also have been corrected.

Because this material is being submitted under protective conditions, copies are not on file with the Postal Service library.
