NOTICE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
REGARDING INTENTION TO CONDUCT ORAL CROSS-EXAMINATION
OF MAIL ORDER ASSOCIATION OF AMERICA WITNESS PRESCOTT

In accordance with Rule 30(e)(3), the United States Postal Service hereby gives notice of its intention to conduct oral cross-examination of Mail Order Association of America (MOAA) witness Prescott regarding his rebuttal testimony, MOAA-RT-1. Any such cross-examination is expected to be light.

The Postal Service files this notice cognizant that witness Prescott is a resident of the greater metropolitan area of Washington, DC, who would accordingly have no need to make long distance travel arrangements in advance of an appearance before the Postal Rate Commission. Should Postal Service counsel conclude, in advance of witness Prescott's scheduled appearance on November 29, 2006, that the Postal Service has no cross-examination of its own, counsel for MOAA will be so notified. The Postal Service would reserve, in any event, the right to follow upon the cross-examination of witness Prescott by other participants.
