The Postal Service hereby provides notice that it is withdrawing its request for a recommended decision on classifications, rates, and fees to implement a baseline negotiated service agreement (NSA) with Washington Mutual Bank. Accordingly, the co-proponents have concurrently moved to close Docket No. MC2006-3 by issuing an order to that effect. See Joint Motion by United States Postal Service and Washington Mutual Bank to Close Docket.

The co-proponents in the instant proceeding have determined that, in light of changes in circumstances, it would be in their common best interests not to proceed with the proposed NSA. The co-proponents do not believe that any participant would be prejudiced by the withdrawal of the request.
