**MOTION OF THE McGRAW-HILL COMPANIES TO FILE
CORRECTED BRIEF**

The McGraw-Hill Companies, Inc. (McGraw-Hill), through its undersigned counsel, respectfully seeks leave to file the accompanying corrected version of the Initial Brief that it filed on December 21, 2006. As originally filed, due to oversight, McGraw-Hill's Initial Brief did not use the Arial font preferred by the Commission. Using Arial font caused the brief to run about two pages longer, requiring correction of page numbers in the table of contents and table of authorities. In the process of making those corrections, two citations from the body of the brief that inadvertently had not been reflected in the table of authorities were added thereto.

Further, it has come to the attention of counsel for McGraw-Hill that the version of its Initial Brief that was electronically filed on December 21 was not the latest version that had been prepared for filing, which had corrected five typographical errors and added three clarifying words, as follows (referring to pages of the brief as initially filed):

Table of Contents, part III.A.2, correct "Name" to "None".

Page 9, on the tenth line and the last line, correct "piecemail" to "piecemeal".

Page 14, footnote 13, line 3, correct "container-bundling" to "container-handling".

Page 17, line 3, insert in the parenthetical, after "which", a comma and the words "standing alone, would".

Page 21, add a period after the word "in" at the end of the first paragraph in the indented and single-spaced quotation.

No other changes have been made to McGraw-Hill's Initial Brief as originally timely filed on December 21, 2006. McGraw-Hill submits that no party will be prejudiced by granting its motion to resubmit its Initial Brief in the Arial font preferred by the Commission, and with the minor corrections and clarification listed above, which will assist the Commission and the parties in considering the views of McGraw-Hill in this proceeding.
