We are very confident that the new Postal Accountability and Enhancement Act (PAEA) will allow the mailing industry to work very closely with the Postal Regulatory Commission and the United States Postal Service to assure a viable and healthy postal system in the future. We commend your organization and the USPS for taking the time to conduct the summit that was held on March 13, 2007.
