**NOTICE OF INTERVENTION
OF THE NATIONAL NEWSPAPER ASSOCIATION
(APRIL 19, 2007)**

Pursuant to Section 20 of the Commission's Rules, the National Newspaper Association, Inc. (NNA) hereby gives notice of its intervention as a full participant in the above-captioned proceeding.

1. NNA is an association of community newspapers, which are heavy users of the Within County and Outside County Periodicals subclasses as well as Standard Mail. NNA represents nearly 2,500 newspapers nationwide. NNA's members have in the past sought authority to use Repositionable Notes in the Within County subclass at a rate that is competitive in the marketplace, but have not succeeded in obtaining such a rate from the Postal Service.

2. NNA believes settlement conferences should be convened under Rule 69 to permit it to attempt to reach an agreement with the Postal Service on an acceptable RPN rate for within-county periodicals. If no agreement is possible, NNA would oppose treatment of this docket as a minor classification change and would also request a short period for discovery, and possibly a hearing on this matter.

3. NNA at this time opposes suspension of the docket.
