ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR RECEIPT OF TESTIMONY, ACCEPTING  
DESIGNATIONS OF WRITTEN CROSS-EXAMINATION, AND CLOSING THE  
EVIDENTIARY RECORD

(May 23, 2007)

The Postal Service requests that the direct testimony of witness Yeh (USPS-T-1) be received into evidence in Docket No. MC2006-7.<sup>1</sup> The Motion is accompanied by an original signed declaration from the witness attesting to the authenticity and accuracy of her written direct testimony. The Motion is granted.

The Office of the Consumer Advocate (OCA) and David B. Popkin (Mr. Popkin) request that various interrogatory responses be included in the record of this proceeding. OCA designates the following interrogatory responses of the Postal Service as its written cross-examination:<sup>2</sup>

OCA/USPS-T1-3-4, 13-17, 19, 30-34; and

DBP/USPS-1 (revised March 13, 2007), 2-3, 8, 17, 19-30, 40-41, 46, 48, 50-52, 55, 61, 65-67, and 70.

OCA designates the following interrogatory responses of Postal Service witness Yeh as its written cross-examination:<sup>3</sup>

OCA/USPS-T1-1, 5-12, 18, 20-24, 27-29;

DBP/USPS-32-33, 35-37; and

DFC/USPS-T1-1-10, 12-17, and 30.

Mr. Popkin designates the following interrogatory responses of the Service as his written cross-examination:<sup>4</sup>

DFC/USPS-T1-1-18, 23-30; and

DBP/USPS-1 (revised March 13, 2007), 2-57, 61-62, 64-67, and 69-71.

The Service has filed an original signed declaration from the witness attesting to the authenticity and accuracy of the written interrogatory responses.<sup>5</sup>

The aforementioned designations are hereby entered into the evidentiary record and the evidentiary record in this proceeding is closed.

*It is ordered:*

1. The Motion of the United States Postal Service for Receipt of Direct Testimony into Evidence, dated April 26, 2007, is granted.
2. The designations discussed in the body of this Order are accepted for inclusion into the record.
