**RESPONSE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE TO RULING
OF THE PRESIDING OFFICER AT HEARING ON JUNE 14, 2007**
(June 15, 2007)

The Postal Service hereby provides its response to the Presiding Officer's ruling from the bench at the June 14, 2007 hearing on the Postal Service's direct case. The Presiding Officer asked the Postal Service to indicate whether any reports or documents were submitted to the Board of Governors (BOG) that discuss improvements in accept rates attributable to the Postal Service's investments in Wide Field of View (WFOV) Cameras. The undersigned counsel understand that while no documents have yet been identified as being responsive to the Presiding Officer's ruling, there are a few documents that were submitted to the Board of Governors that contain information on improvements resulting from a Performance Improvement Plan (PIP) implemented in connection with the WFOV Cameras. While not responsive to the query raised at the hearing, in the interest of economy of Commission resources, by Tuesday, June 19, 2007, the undersigned counsel will file a motion to submit these documents under protective conditions similar to, but more restrictive than, those in Presiding Officer's Ruling No. MC2007-1/4 (with redactions for material unrelated to the accept rates of the WFOV Cameras). The undersigned counsel will continue to search for documents

responsive to this ruling and will submit an update should any other documents be identified as responsive. The undersigned counsel have contacted and advised counsel for APWU of this response.
