Pursuant to Commission rules, the Bradford Group seeks waiver of the Commission's requirement to file two hard copies and an electronic version of this

Library Reference. 39 C.F.R. § 3001.31(b)(2)(viii) and (x). The materials constitute examples of mailpieces as these were mailed to Bradford prospective customers. Thus, two copies of each mailpiece cannot be reasonably produced in this format. In addition, recognizing the source of the mailpieces, corresponding material is generally not readily accessible in electronic version, and may no longer be available.
