The United States Postal Service hereby provides notice of errata to the Direct Testimony of Broderick A. Parr on Behalf of the United States Postal Service, filed on August 3, 2007. Several items were inadvertently excluded from the Proposed Data Collection Plan in the testimony of witness Parr. Changes were made to the Proposed Data Collection Plan (Appendix E) as follows:

- Items 4-8 were added to the list of items in the Postal Service's Proposed Data Collection Plan.
- The first sentence was revised to read as follows: "The USPS plans to collect the following data pertaining to the NSA with Bradford Group and include the following items in its Data Collection Plan:"

No other changes to the testimony have been made. A complete version of the testimony, including the revised Appendix E, has been filed to replace the version filed on August 3, 2007. The Excel file of the Postal Service's financial model, originally filed

on August 3, has been filed along with the revised testimony today for the convenience of the parties, though it has not changed.
