ORDER EXTENDING DATES FOR
RESPONSIVE COMMENTS

(Issued August 29, 2007)

On August 15, 2007, Commission Order No. 26 published proposed rules for implementing a modern system of rate regulation. The order allotted 30 days for comments and an additional 14 days for reply comments. The order also directed that the proposed rules and explanatory material be published in the *Federal Register*.

Publication of Order No. 26 in the *Federal Register* has been delayed for an unusual and unanticipated length of time. The Commission is committed to expediting the development of these important rules and has determined to extend the dates for comments in order to assure that the public has an adequate opportunity to provide views.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. The date for interested persons to submit comments on Order No. 26 is extended from September 14, 2007 to September 24, 2007.

2. The date for interested persons to submit reply comments is extended from September 28, 2007 to October 9, 2007.
3. Other filing dates established in Order No. 26 remain unchanged.
